As you have noticed, the February Water Bills were "Estimated" as well as the January Bills. The bills are based on the minimum amount of water or 1000 gallons each month. If you use considerably more, we would recommend that you pay your regular monthly amount. When the meters are finally read, the usage table in the Village computer will reflect that number of months times the gallons.

If you only pay the minimum bill of \$60.12 and you normally pay \$80.00, you will find that it will catch up with your actual usage and you will owe a much larger amount once the meters are read. We are just trying to avoid "sticker" shock once the meters are read.

A notice was put in the Post Office last month to make you aware of this and thought you should be reminded about "Estimated" billing.
