Remember Bulky Waste Clean Up Day is May 1st. A list is posted of acceptable items at the Village Hall kiosk, Post Office, and TBK Bank. Please have your items set out by 6 A.M. Saturday morning for Moring to pick up.

Please remember as you are out walking your dog and enjoying the spring weather that you must remove any dog defecation immediately if you are on any public property such as school grounds, public streets, alleys, sidewalks, tree banks, parkways, or any other public grounds or on any private property within the village, other than the premises of the

owner, keeper, or person having custody of the dog. A first offense violation can result in a fine of \$10.00 to \$25.00. Each offense thereafter is a \$25.00 to \$200.00 fine.

The Village of Chadwick will be flushing hydrants from May 3rd through May 14th. There may be a slight drop in pressure or a presence of discoloration from the minerals and sediments that are being flushed out of the system.

At the Committee meeting on April 26th, the trustees have agreed that there will no longer be a credit to the sewer portion of the water bill for those residents with pools. This courtesy was supposed to have stopped years ago.
